1. Rashad just got a new puppy. During his first vet appointment, Rashad sees a brochure for pet insurance. The insurance would cost Rashad \$60 per month, but it would cover all vet costs after Rashad meets a \$500 deductible. What should Rashad do?
 - a. Buy pet insurance.
 - b. Don't buy pet insurance.
2. Blair is buying her first cell phone. The cell phone costs her \$1,000. She opts to pay for it over two years. The cell phone company offers her insurance in case her phone breaks, but it will cost her an additional \$150 over the course of two years. What should Blair do?
 - a. Buy cell phone insurance.
 - b. Don't buy cell phone insurance.
3. Ethan's brother Parker is about to propose to his girlfriend. When he buys the ring, the jeweler asks if he would like to buy insurance to cover the ring if it gets lost or stolen, or if stones fall out. The insurance costs \$50 per year to insure for 5 years. What should Parker do?
 - a. Buy ring insurance.
 - b. Don't buy ring insurance.
